## **Parents' Evenings**

Many thanks to all parents and carers who attended these earlier this month – the attendance rate was 89% which was the highest we have had for some time. We hope it was useful and provided information on your child's progress and the areas they will be working on for the rest of the academic year.

Further thanks to all who supported our book fair which was held at the same time. It raised over £1000 in sales which in turn generated over £500 of free books for the school – these will be used to replenish the stock in our library areas. Thanks to Mrs Peat, our librarian, for her excellent work in organising this event.
