We are now entering the period of administering various tests and assessments as required by the Department for Education. For the benefit of parents of children in these year groups, the dates of these are below:

Year 6: Mon 8th to Thurs 11th May.

Year 2: Weds 17th/Thurs 18th/Mon 22nd and Tues 23rd May.

Year 1: Mon 12th to Fri 16th June.

Parents of children in these classes are strongly advised to ensure that their children are in school on time during the period applicable to them and that they get plenty of sleep and rest during this time.
