Dear Parents/Carers,

We are arranging a visit to **Warwick Castle** on **Friday 7th June 2019** for Penguins and Seals. This visit will support our learning journey which is 'Towers, Tunnels and Turrets'. We shall travel by coach and leave school **9 am** and return at approximately **4 pm**. Please note the later time back. The cost of this trip will be **£16.95**

For the trip your child will need the following:

1. School uniform

4. A packed lunch with a drink (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). (If you would like school to provide a packed lunch with cheese sandwich please indicate on the reply slip below).

Due to the charges we must ask for a voluntary contribution of £16.95 towards the cost of the trip (entrance fee £10.25 which includes a workshop, £6.60 coach fare, insurance 10p) The 1988 Education Act and Governors' Policy requires us to make it clear that our intended visit can only take place if parents are prepared to make a voluntary contribution. There is no obligation to contribute and no child will be omitted from taking part, however it will be necessary to have **substantial parental contributions** for the visit to go ahead. **If you are unable to make a contribution for whatever reason, you MUST contact Mr Smith.**
