Winter Weather Procedures

If severe weather strikes, please assume that the school is open unless you are informed otherwise.

If we are closed, you will be informed by text message, the school website, Twitter and e-mail by 7.15 at the latest. Local radio stations will also be contacted. We will use the same methods to inform you of re-opening arrangements.

If snow falls during the day and the forecast is poor, we may begin a 'rolling' closure where you can collect your child earlier and from a specific time. If this does happen, we will let you know through the same methods described above.

Anti-Bullying and Pupil Safety

We introduced a new Anti-Bullying programme called KiVa last month as part of a pilot project being carried out in schools across Birmingham. This includes lessons and a range of strategies designed to identify and tackle instances of bullying in schools. An information leaflet was emailed to parents at the beginning of the month, please let us know if you didn't receive this.

Continuing the theme of safety, we now have 8 pupils in Years 5 and 6 trained as Junior PCSOs. This is a partnership between the school and West Midlands Police and involves children taking part in Anti-Bullying work, reducing litter, property marking and carrying out parking patrols in local streets. You will be seeing them at work in their high visibility jackets over the coming months!

School Standards

Earlier this month we received final confirmation of the standards reached by our Year 6 pupils in July 2019. They are below with the national average in brackets:

Pupils reaching the expected standard:

-Reading: 82% (73%) -Writing: 91% (78%)

-Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: 89% (78%)

-Maths: 88% (79%)

-Reading/Writing/Maths combined: 77% (65%)

Pupils reaching the higher standard:

-Reading: 45% (27%) -Writing: 27% (20%)

-Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: 66% (36%)

-Maths: 52% (27%)

-Reading/Writing/Maths combined: 16% (11%)

These results represent the hard work of the children and all of the staff who supported them during their time at the school – well done to all!
