Requests for information

The school receives several requests for different kinds of information from parents and families throughout the year. Most of the time these are straightforward and can be dealt with quickly. However, there are times when an immediate response is not possible, this can be due to the information being requested (it may be detailed) or the member of staff responsible for dealing with the request may not be available. In these instances, the school aim to meet the request no later than 5 working days from the date it was made but will always try to do this sooner.

Requests made under data protection legislation have separate timelines and these are explained when the school provides its initial written acknowledgement of the request.

Parents' evenings

Parents' evenings will be held on Tuesday 20th and Thursday 22nd February after school. You will have the opportunity to look at your child's work since September and discuss their progress up until this point. Bookings will be online via the School Cloud system and the window for this will open shortly.
