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### Parents' Evenings

The recent set of parents' evenings were the first conducted virtually and they saw the highest booking rates for many years. We have received lots of positive feedback with the main themes being: convenience (no requirement to travel to school); appointments running to time and parents being able to join meetings from different places. A link to a survey was sent out just before half-term and the findings will help us make a decision as to how we will hold future sessions.

### Annual Report

This will be sent home on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> July and, together with the recent parents' evening, should provide a clear understanding of your child's achievements along with identifying the areas they can improve upon next year.

### Covid-19 Measures

Local infection rates continue to remain below the national average but we must remain vigilant, especially as the end of term approaches and there will be families hoping to get away for holidays in the early part of the summer break.

- Follow all self-isolation guidelines if your child or a household member develop symptoms.
- Do not send a child into school while a test result is being awaited (either for the child or a household member).
- A negative result on a rapid 30-minute test does not override self-isolation.
- Keep your children with you when they are on site, do not allow them to run ahead of you or mix with other children.
- Observe social distancing while you are waiting on site and avoid congregating on pavements and pathways.

On the next page you will see some dates and times of end of year events. The next phase of the national easing of restrictions will determine what we are allowed to do in terms of these going ahead so they are not confirmed. However, they have been included so they can be put into your diary and we will update you about the status of these as soon as we can.

### Safeguarding

The school takes its safeguarding duty very seriously. If you have any concerns about the safety or well-being of a child, then you must contact the school or the Birmingham Children's Advice and Support Service on 0121-303-1888 in confidence.

The school will always act in the best interests of a child whenever a concern arises. This does mean that other professionals may be contacted before parents are informed of a concern that a child has disclosed. This is a nationwide approach and one that is followed in this school.

### Class Allocations for September

Children will find out who their class teacher is for next year on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> July. Ideally, this will take the usual format where the class will spend the morning with them. Again, it is something we will make a final decision about once we know the restrictions that are likely to be in place at that point.

### Attendance

Our attendance figure to date is 97.5%, this compares to a current national average of 96.1%. Children across the school have made rapid progress since returning in March and it is no coincidence that attendance has been high during this period. Specific figures for each year group are below:

Reception: 97.4%	Year 1: 97.0%
Year 2: 98.0%	Year 3: 97.9%
Year 4: 97.1%	Year 5: 98.4%
Year 6: 96.5%	

A reminder that any late children are to report to the office and not to classroom doors, this helps staff to have an accurate picture of attendance and enables the school site to be secured promptly.
