Opening Up

We returned to holding Collective Worship in the hall at the start of this month and the groups of children gathering together will increase in size as the weeks go on. The aim is to have all classes in each of our Encourage and Inspire groups coming together before the end of term.

IMPORTANT NOTICE - PARKING

- -A timestamp of the photograph or evidence of the date and time when it was taken.
- -A brief description of the obstruction/breach.

Once you have this:

- 2) Select 'West Midlands Police'.
- 3) Complete the online form.

Reports are then sent directly to the WM Police Central Ticket Office for processing and fines are issued automatically.
